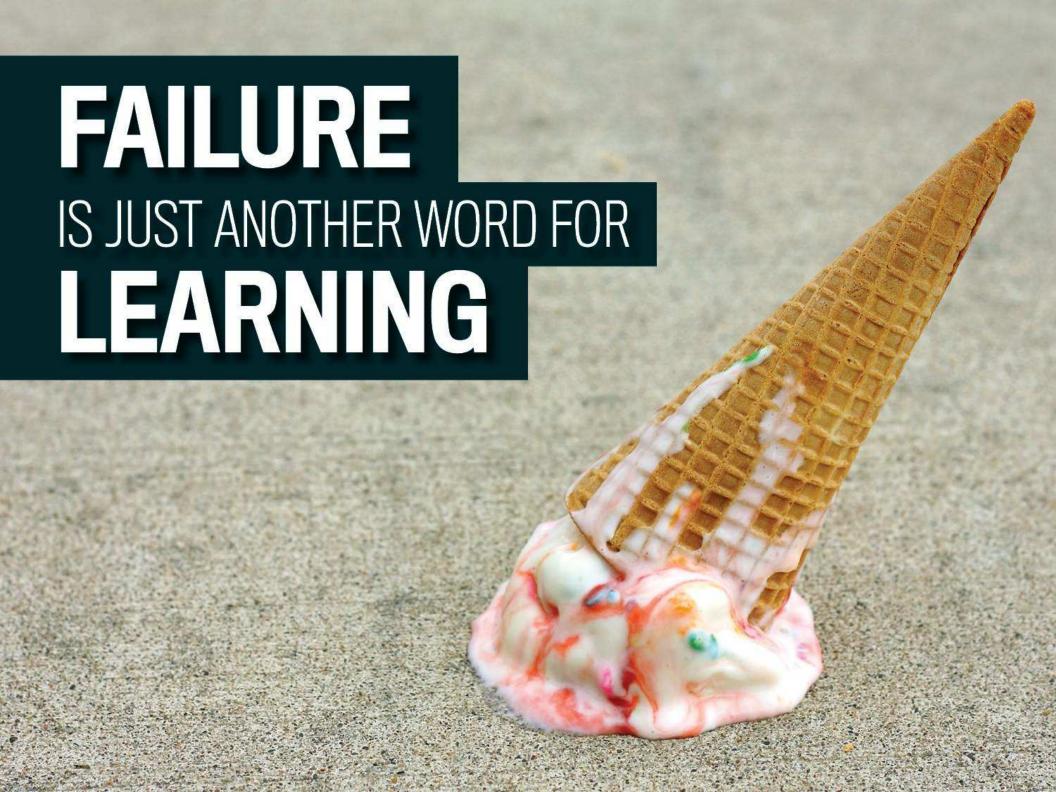






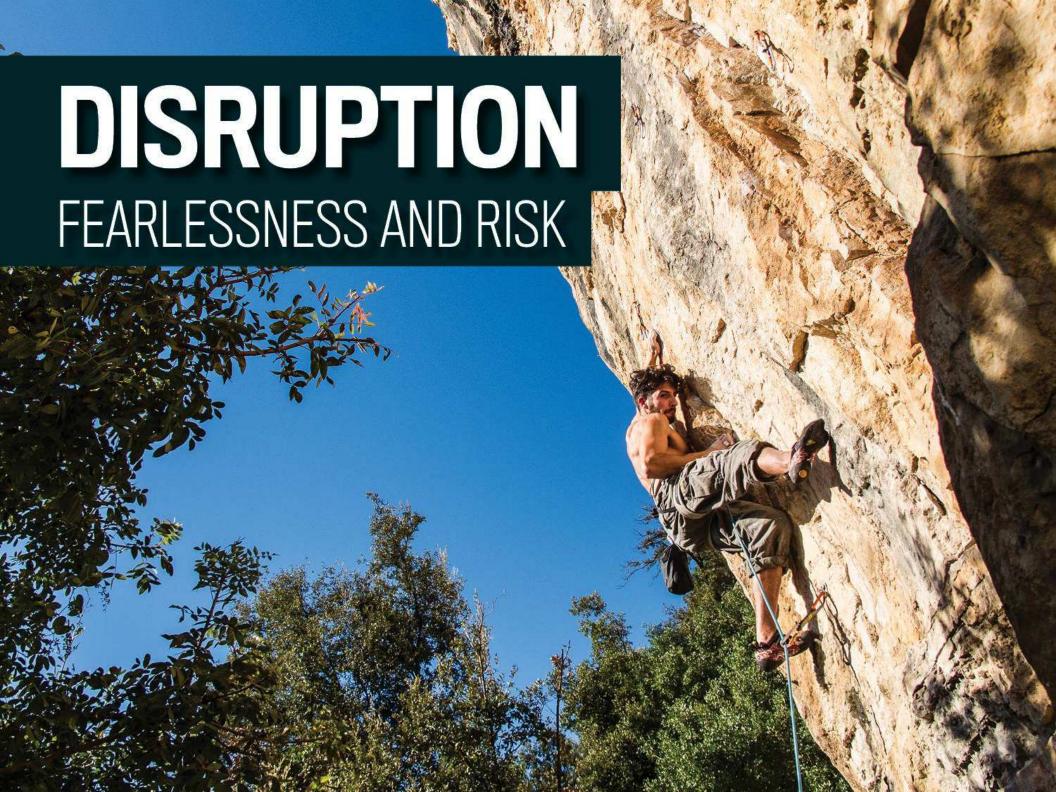






Lesson learned: HOW TO BE A SUCCESSFUL ENTREPRENEUR
